Statement of reasons: Roma to Brisbane Gas Pipeline

Annual Gas Tariff Variation

On 18 April 2023, Roma to Brisbane Gas Pipeline applied to the AER for variation of its gas reference tariffs for the period 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024.

In 2023–24, Roma to Brisbane Gas Pipeline’s transmission reference tariffs will increase by 1.80%.

The AER has carefully reviewed Roma to Brisbane Gas Pipeline’s application in line with its 2022–27 access arrangement and is satisfied the tariff variation proposal complies with the access arrangement.

The transmission network tariff increases are driven by the updated price path (X factor) from the 2022–27 access arrangement (an increase of 0.41%) and the 7.83% increase in the CPI in the year to December 2022, as well as other mechanistic adjustments for rebateable services and similar.

Having considered Roma to Brisbane Gas Pipeline’s tariff variation proposal and finding it compliant, the AER approves these tariffs for commencement from 1 July 2023.
