

Accuracy of Market Liquidity Obligation register details

What is the Market Liquidity Obligation (MLO) register?

The MLO register sets out the MLO generators and MLO groups in participating NEM regions responsible for performing the MLO. The National Electricity Rules require the AER to establish, maintain and publish the MLO register in accordance with the MLO Guidelines. There is also a requirement for market participants with scheduled generating units or scheduled bidirectional units to notify the AER of any updates or changes to their portfolio information within 10 business days.

What is the Retailer Reliability Obligation (RRO) generator portal?

To assist generators and integrated resource providers in providing portfolio information required under the National Electricity Rules, the AER has developed the RRO generator portal to provide a streamlined method to submit necessary information.

What are the requirements for market generators and integrated resource providers?

Market generators and integrated resource providers that have scheduled generating units or scheduled bidirectional units in their portfolios are reminded of the requirement to update information in the RRO generator portal within 10 business days in the event the details of their scheduled generating or bidirectional units change, or new units have been commissioned. This is to ensure the MLO register remains accurate. This is necessary for all participants with scheduled generating units or scheduled bidirectional units, including existing MLO generators and MLO groups, as well as any new market participants with scheduled generating units or scheduled bidirectional units.

Market participants with scheduled generating units or scheduled bidirectional units should ensure that they have access to the portal and that their scheduled production information is up to date.
