Dear People, Please reconsider Marinus Link in the light of New Technology that outstrips tri-blade wind turbine power farms and long distance transmission of power to Victoria from Tasmania.

All we need is a Communications Cable. We will be much better off with locally generated electricity by many different methods optimising suburbs, towns and cities as Renewable Energy Zones in their own right .

The Chinese have cable cutters that can sever our undersea cables very easily. Pylons fail more frequently now in climate driven super storms, and far too many people lose power, which does not happen in Embedded Power Hubs.

Transmission corridors lay waste thousands of sqr kilometers of high quality natural values forests, which does not happen in Urban Power Hubs.

In fact the reverse is true....street trees can replace poles and wires in urban settings. Rural properties are far better off being off grid. The dangers from transmission infrastructure in rural areas far outweigh any benefits.

Cutting corridors through bushland degrades and separates intact areas greatly reducing their intrinsic values.

Tasmania does not need to suffer exploitation by proffit driven power companies. That is a SELL OUT.
