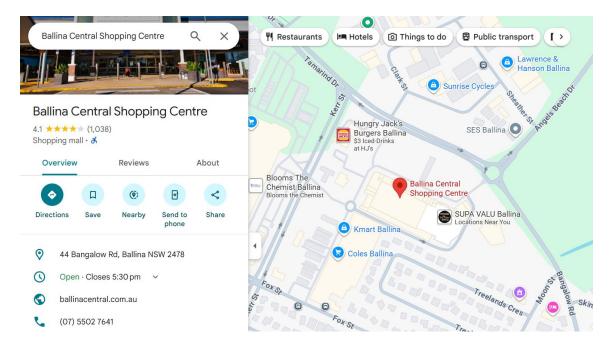

As per discussions with the AER Energy Bay assists REIT clients to achieve their decarbonisation goals by installing and operating Solar and Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) within Embedded Networks at commercial properties. Ancillary to this installation and operating of solar and BESS Energy Bay on-sells electricity to customers within the embedded network. For this reason we believe an exemption is the most appropriate path.

Energy Bay's primary activity is the installation and operation of Solar and BESS within commercial properties, often within Embedded Networks. Please refer to response to question 6 above.

Other options include the appointment of another ENO by mutual agreement.

The read cycle for billing will be monthly and meters will be read by the MP and billed through RMS utilities

N/A, Customers will be separately metered.

The read cycle for billing will be monthly and customers will be billed an Electricity invoice through our billing agent RMS utilities.

Dispute resolution procedures have been established and are consistent with AS ISO 10002-2002 and a copy has been included with this application..

No Residential Customers will form part of this Embedded Network. Any Small Business Rebates applicable will be applied to customers accounts following the application process (if any)

As noted above Energy Bay installs Solar and Bess at commercial sites for REIT clients which customers have available to them, Net metering will be utilised.
