Waratah Super Battery (WSB) 2026 PG Contestable Adjustment Proposal

The Australian Energy Regulator's (AER) final decision on the Waratah Super Battery (WSB) Contestable Paired Generation (PG) Services Service Component (AER's Final Decision) requires Transgrid to submit adjustment proposals for approved adjustment mechanisms following a relevant trigger event as set out in the PG Service Agreements or this determination, supported by evidence demonstrating how each applicable adjustment event or mechanism has been applied.

In accordance with this requirement, Transgrid has prepared its 2026 WSB contestable PG adjustment proposal, supported by an updated financial model and accompanying evidence for the following adjustments:

- The execution of a new PG Services Agreement with White Rock Wind Farm and the adjustments to the schedule of payments for this fourth Paired Generation Provider
- Delayed commencement of PG Services for Metz Project Co Trust (FRV) and SWF1 Operations Pty Ltd (CWP) and
- The successful completion of the FRV PG Test.

We appreciate the AER's engagement to date on this adjustment proposal and welcome the opportunity to continue discussions with the AER on this matter.
