Statement of reasons: Roma to Brisbane Pipeline Annual Tariff Variation

The AER approves Roma to Brisbane Pipeline's 2026–27 tariff variation notice which contains a tariff that will commence on 1 July 2026. Roma to Brisbane Pipeline's approved tariff is set out on [our website](#).

In 2026–27, Roma to Brisbane Pipeline's transmission reference tariff will increase by 14.2%. The transmission tariff increase is driven by inflation, the real price path set in the 2022–27 access arrangement, the annual updates to the regulated rate of return, the rebateable services adjustment factor and the AER approved cost pass through.

The AER found that the tariff variation is consistent with the mechanisms set in Chapter 4 of its 2022–27 access arrangement and is satisfied the tariff variation proposal is consistent with the access arrangement.

We note gas retailers ultimately determine how these underlying network tariffs are reflected in the retail prices offered to customers.
