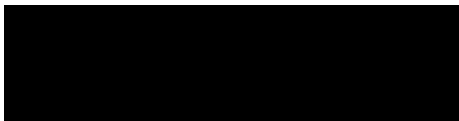
SURRENDER OF RETAILER AUTHORISATION (G25001)

As a delegate of the Australian Energy Regulator (**AER**), having been satisfied with the arrangements relating to the surrender of Agora Retail Pty Limited (ABN 68 612 806 381) retailer authorisation, I have decided, pursuant to subsection 105(3) of the *National Energy Retail Law*, to approve the surrender of Agora Retail Pty Limited's retailer authorisation (with identification number G25001) (**the surrender**).

Pursuant to paragraph 105(4)(b) of the *National Energy Retail Law*, I have decided that the surrender shall take effect on 11 September 2026.

The reasons for my decision are set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

As a delegate of the Australian Energy Regulator (AER) for the purposes of section 105 of the *National Energy Retail Law* (Retail Law), I have considered an application from Agora Retail Pty Limited (ABN 68 612 806 381) received 23 July 2026 to surrender its retailer authorisation (with identification number G25001). Pursuant to subsection 105(3) of the Retail Law, I may decide to approve the surrender of a retailer authorisation if I am satisfied that arrangements relating to the surrender of Agora Retail Pty Limited's retailer authorisation will appropriately manage the transfer of Agora Retail Pty Limited's retail customers.

Agora Retail Pty Limited submitted, as part of its application, that it has no existing retail customers, or obligations to prior customers, and that it has no intention of retailing gas within relevant jurisdictions in the future.

Accordingly, there are no customers to be transferred. There are no conditions attached to the surrender, and the surrender shall take effect on 11 September 2026. I am satisfied the requirements of subsection 105(3) have been met.
