

AEMO transmission determination

- Pricing methodology
 - Answers the question: "who should pay how much" for transmissions services
- Negotiating framework
 - Establishes the procedures for negotiating the terms and conditions of access to negotiated transmission services
- Negotiated transmission service criteria (NSTC)



The AER's role

Assess:

- The proposed pricing methodology against the NER and the AER's guidelines; and
- The proposed negotiating framework against clause 6A.9.4(c)(1)-(9) of the NER.
- Develop:
 - The NTSC for AEMO in consultation with stakeholders




Need for determination

- For the purposes of Chapter 6A of the NER, AEMO is considered to be a TNSP.
- The previous transmission determination for AEMO expires on 30 June 2014.
