2014 GAS NETWORK TARIFF SUBMISSION

Please find enclosed the proposed Gas Network haulage reference tariffs for SPI Networks (Gas) Pty Ltd (SP AusNet) gas network customers for the period from 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2014. SP AusNet tariffs have been adjusted in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's Final Decision on SP AusNet's Access Arrangement dated 29 April 2013.

Distribution Tariffs

In setting the Distribution Tariffs, account has been taken of the Commission's Price Determination that tariffs be adjusted by CPI – X. Volume data is as reported for the calendar year 2012 for the SP AusNet supply area.

As outlined in SP AusNet's previous Tariff Reports, we have continued to build on the 2003 separation of Tariff V into domestic and non-domestic customer categories. Some further rebalancing in 2014 has been undertaken to reflect the different consumption profiles between these two customer groups. The historical cost allocation between the Central and West regions and existing towns and new towns has also been maintained.

SP AusNet's average price change for 2014 is -3.95%. This adjustment is made up of:

- the CPI increase of 2.16%:
- the X of -6.00%:
- licence fee adjustment -0.01%;

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Carbon Levy Tariffs

A separate calculation is included for the recovery of Carbon Levy payments that SP AusNet expects to be making in relation to its fugitive gas emissions in 2014 and a partial true-up for payments made and amounts received in 2013. An audit of SP AusNet's obligations for the financial year 2012/13 has been completed and this audited amount has formed the basis for this submission. SP AusNet's audited liability is \$3,198,311, of which 45% has been allocated to 2013 based on the annual energy profile of customers' use. An estimate for 2013/14 and 2014/15 have been used to complete the 2013 liability and to forecast the 2014 liability. These amounts have been allocated to calendar years on the same basis as 2012/13.

Using the methodology described, SP AusNet has set Carbon tariffs to recover \$3,582,911 in 2014, the rates set are 9% higher. Combined with the Distribution Use of System Tariffs the overall change in prices is -3.66%.
