Monthly Weather Review Australia April 2015



The *Monthly Weather Review - Australia* is produced by the Bureau of Meteorology to provide a concise but informative overview of the temperatures, rainfall and significant weather events in Australia for the month.

To keep the *Monthly Weather Review* as timely as possible, much of the information is based on electronic reports. Although every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of these reports, the results can be considered only preliminary until complete quality control procedures have been carried out. Any major discrepancies will be noted in later issues.

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Units of measurement

Except where noted, *temperature* is given in degrees Celsius (°C), *rainfall* in millimetres (mm), and *wind speed* in kilometres per hour (km/h).

Observation times and periods

Each station in Australia makes its main observation for the day at 9 am local time. At this time, the precipitation over the past 24 hours is determined, and maximum and minimum thermometers are also read and reset. In this publication, the following conventions are used for assigning dates to the observations made:

Maximum temperatures are for the 24 hours *from* 9 am on the date mentioned. They normally occur in the afternoon of that day.

Minimum temperatures are for the 24 hours *to* 9 am on the date mentioned. They normally occur in the early morning of that day.

Mean temperatures are the average of the daily maximum and daily minimum temperatures.

Daily rainfall is for the 24 hours *to* 9 am on the date mentioned. This means a significant fraction of the rain may have occurred on the previous calendar day.

Monthly rainfall is for the period from 9 am on the last day of the previous month to 9 am on the last day of this month.

Maximum daily wind gusts are in the 24 hours from midnight to midnight.

Climatological values

The climatological averages shown in the text and tables are generally long-term means based on observations from the years 1961–1990. They are not shown for sites with less than 25 years of record in that time, as they cannot then be calculated reliably. Climatological extremes are generally taken from all available years of record; the number of years can vary markedly from site to site.

Records

The tables of records are not exhaustive, as they only show sites with at least 30 years of record. This may exclude locations where a new site has been established; this means even some major cities and towns may not be listed.

Maps

The temperature and rainfall maps are intended to give an overview of the country. There could be discrepancies between the values shown on these maps and those at individual locations, as a result of the way the maps are generated. A wide range of maps of rainfall, temperature and other variables, covering the whole country and smaller regions can be found at www.bom.gov.au/climate/maps.

Overview

- Cool in the southern mainland, particularly Western Australia
- Days warmer than average for the far north
- Rainfall above average for parts of Western Australia and the mainland southeast, but not central and western Victoria
- A very dry April for Tasmania

Maximum temperatures for April were below to very much below average across most of the mainland, excluding the far north where they were warmer than average. Western Australia had particularly cool days, with monthly maxima the sixth-coolest on record for April. Overnight minima were near-average for much of Australia, with parts of New South Wales and the coastal west and far northern Queensland observing warmer-than-average nights, while nights were cooler than average in eastern Queensland, central Australia and small areas along the mainland south coast.

Averaged nationally, maximum temperatures were the eighteenth-coolest on record for April (1.02 °C below average). Minimum temperatures were also cooler than average (0.37 °C below the long-term average), yielding a mean temperature for April 0.69 °C below average.

Rainfall was higher than average for most of New South Wales, eastern South Australia and eastern Victoria. Two East Coast Lows during the month contributed, bringing exceedingly heavy rainfall to the New South Wales coast. Rainfall was also above average for much of western and central Western Australia. Rainfall was below average in parts of the north, and very much below average in Tasmania, which had its fifth-driest April on record. Nationally, rainfall was 12% below average.

A Special Climate Statement was issued, discussing the prolonged heatwave.

In this table *Hottest day* is the highest daily maximum temperature, *Coldest night* is the lowest daily minimum temperature, *Wettest day* is the highest daily rainfall total, *Warmest overall* is the highest mean monthly temperature, *Coolest overall* is the lowest mean monthly temperature and *Wettest overall* is the highest total monthly precipitation.

Significant weather

East Coast Lows

Two East Coast Lows affected New South Wales during the month. The first developed off the south coast of New South Wales on the 7th, causing widespread rainfall totals above 50 mm in southeastern New South Wales and wind gusts as high as 107 km/h at Green Cape on the 8th.

A second East Coast Low developed off the Hunter coast on the evening of the 20th, staying near-stationary and causing severe weather across much of the Sydney and Hunter regions before decaying during the 23rd. The system caused widespread heavy rainfall in the Hunter and Sydney regions, with two-day totals as high as 436 mm at Tocal and Maitland, and hourly totals as high as 112 mm in Tocal on the morning of the 21st. The system also caused prolonged and severe winds, with mean winds exceeding 50 km/h for 44 consecutive hours at Sydney Airport and wind gusts as high as 135 km/h at several locations, while wave heights of up to 14.9 m were recorded at a buoy off Sydney Harbour.

This was the most severe East Coast Low to affect the New South Wales coast since at least June 2007. Major flooding was observed in the Williams and Patersons rivers, with flash flooding reported throughout the Sydney, Hunter, and Central Coast regions. Several fatalities were reported during the event, as a result of flooded roads as well as severe flash flooding in Dungog on the morning of the 21st. Flooding in the Georges River also caused residents to be evacuated from Milperra and Chipping Norton in southwest Sydney.

In addition to the flooding, the strong winds caused roof damage and downed trees and powerlines, with power outages to more than 200 000 homes and some residences in the central coast region losing power for as much as a week. The strong winds and high seas also contributed to substantial coastal erosion, with sand blown well beyond the immediate beachfront. In total, the State Emergency Service reported more than 20 000 jobs and 169 flood rescues during this event, the largest response operation in the history of the service, with Natural Disasters declared in twelve Local Government Areas.

Thunderstorms in New South Wales

Severe storms on the 6th caused 42.5 mm of rain in 30 minutes and hail of 2 cm in diameter in the Newcastle area, with 2.5 cm hail reported from a storm in Dubbo.

Storms in Sydney on the 25th caused large amounts of 2 cm hail, leading to the collapse of several warehouses in western Sydney.

Strong winds in South Australia

A small low pressure system deepened off the southeast coast of South Australia on the 6th and moved northeastwards, crossing the Coorong coast during the late evening. Strong to gale force southerly winds on the western flank of the low affected eastern Kangaroo Island, the southern Mount Lofty Ranges, and coastal parts of the Upper South East district from the afternoon of the 6th through to the early hours of the 7th. At Cape Willoughby and Hindmarsh Island, the southerly winds averaged 60 km/h to 70 km/h, with gusts of 85 km/h to 95 km/h.


A deep low pressure system tracked northeastwards from well southwest of Kangaroo Island during the 24th, with the low centre passing over Kangaroo Island during the evening and Murray Bridge early on 25th. Strong to locally gale force west to southwesterly winds and squally showers and thunderstorms affected areas to the west of the low centre, particularly the lower Eyre Peninsula and Yorke Peninsula during the evening. Westerly winds of 50 km/h to 65 km/h, with gusts to 87 km/h, were recorded at Coles Point, Cummins, and Minlaton between about 5 pm and 8:30 pm.










Tropical cyclones

Tropical cyclone *Ikola* formed to the southwest of the Cocos Island on the 6th, having consolidated from a low formed along the monsoon trough by a pulse of the Madden–Julian Oscillation over the central Indian Ocean early in the month. *Ikola* moved southeast, reaching category 4 strength before weakening to a tropical low on the 8th while still well to the west of Australia. While *Ikola* did not cause damage on any land masses while a cyclone, the remnants of system tracked along the west coast of Western Australia and into the Great Australian Bight between the 9th and 14th. Moderate to heavy rainfall was recorded in parts of the southern third of Western Australia, heaviest in the southwest.

Tropical cyclone *Quang* also formed during April, but made landfall on the coast of Western Australia during May. It will be covered in the May *Monthly Weather Review*.

Synoptic analyses and summary





Synoptic summary

The passage of cold fronts and high pressure systems dominated weather across the south of Australia during April, with surface troughs driving weather in the north and interior. An intense low pressure system also affected the east late in the month.

At the start of the month a cold front crossed the southern mainland while an inland trough extended from the northwest through to the interior of the continent. As the cold front crossed Tasmania, a ridge of high pressure pushed in from the southern Indian Ocean into the Great Australian Bight, directing a south-southwesterly airstream into southern parts of South Australia, Victoria and Tasmania. A second cold front crossed the southeastern mainland on the 6th and merged with a deepening low pressure system over New South Wales. The system intensified as it tracked into the Tasman Sea, directing a strong southeasterly airstream into southeast New South Wales while a cold southerly airstream continued across Victoria and southern New South Wales through to the 10th.

Tropical cyclone *Ikola* formed well to the west of Western Australia, weakened to a low by the time it approached the west coast of Western Australia on the 9th, then formed a tight low which travelled across the Great Australian Bight before being overtaken by a cold front on the 15th.

From the 12th, a series of surface troughs developed over the northwest of the continent, extending into the southeast as several cold fronts crossed the Great Australian Bight and Tasmania through to the 18th. On the 19th, a low pressure centre spun off the last of these cold fronts. This low deepened and intensified as it approached the Hunter and Mid North districts of New South Wales on the 20th. By the 21st the system had developed into an East Coast Low that produced strong and damaging southeasterly to southwesterly winds along the central coast of New South Wales. The low slowly tracked southward and by the 23rd had begun to decay into a broad trough of low pressure over the Tasman Sea.

On the 24th, a deep low pressure system located over the east of the Great Australian Bight extended an associated cold front across coastal South Australia with southwesterly winds persisting across the southeastern mainland through to the 28th ahead of a large high pressure system. The last days of April saw a tropical low deepen on the monsoon trough to the north of Western Australia, forming tropical cyclone *Quang* on the 29th. The cyclone slowly tracked southwards, undergoing rapid intensification to category 4 status on the 30th. Tropical cyclone *Quang* weakened as it tracked towards the coast of northwest Western Australia under the influence of an upper level trough, making landfall on 1 May.


Temperatures

The national April mean temperature was 0.69 °C below average. Mean temperatures for the month were cooler than average for Western Australia away from the west coast and Kimberley; South Australia and adjacent parts of Victoria and New South Wales; the south of the Northern Territory; and inland southeastern Queensland. Both Western Australia and South Australia recorded area-averaged mean temperature anomalies more than one degree cooler than average for April. Mean temperatures were warmer than average for northern Queensland, the Gulf Country, and the Northern Territory's Top End.


Maximum temperatures

The Australian mean maximum temperature for April was 1.02 °C below the long-term average.

Maximum temperatures were more than two degrees cooler than average through the Pilbara, Gascoyne, Goldfields and Eucla in Western Australia, leading to that State's sixth-coolest April on record for maximum temperatures (-1.78°C). Just over 60% of Western Australia recorded maximum temperatures in the lowest 10% of records (decile 1) for the month with a number of daily and monthly records (see page 0) set. South Australia, southern parts of Northern Territory,

southeast Queensland away from the coast, and large parts of Victoria and New South Wales also saw maximum temperatures one to two degrees cooler than average.

Maximum temperatures were warmer than average across the eastern Kimberley, the Top End, around the Gulf of Carpentaria, and across the Cape York Peninsula and adjacent regions of northern Queensland. Monthly records (see page 0) were set in some parts of the north.

The first week of April was warmer than average for the tropical north. Between the 6th and 9th the passage of a cold front and trailing high pressure system brought cool days to much of southern Australia. Beginning in the southwest on the 10th a tight low drew warm air southward from central Australia, with warmer-than-average days occurring across much of the mainland by the 13th as the low stalled behind a high pressure system tracking south of Tasmania.

The 14th and 15th were more than eight degrees warmer than average in parts of central Australia to western New South Wales and more moderately warm for areas farther north, before the warmth contracted into northern New South Wales ahead of high pressure ridging over the southwest on the 17th.

The 16th was cooler than average for the southern half of Western Australia, extending to western Victoria, with following days seeing below-average temperatures expand across most of the south of Australia. Very low daytime temperatures were observed between the 18th and 23rd in parts of the Pilbara and surrounds in Western Australia, with many sites in the Pilbara, northern Goldfields, and Southern Interior experiencing their coolest April day on record.


From the 20th to the 22nd, cool air was drawn north on the western flank of an East Coast Low, bringing very cold days to central and northeastern New South Wales and southeastern Queensland. Maxima in some areas were more than ten degrees below average, with numerous sites breaking their April low maximum temperature record.

Conditions remained generally cooler than average across Australia for the remainder of the month as a slow-moving high tracked across the Great Australian Bight.


Minimum temperatures

Minimum temperatures were generally closer to average for April, with the national mean minimum temperature 0.37 °C below the long-term mean.

Areas of below-average monthly minima were observed in through central Australia, an area of eastern Queensland extending into the Central

Highlands district, as well as smaller areas of western Victoria, southeastern and southern agricultural South Australia, western Tasmania and between the central south coast and inland Pilbara in Western Australia. Minima were warmer than average for the coastal Pilbara and Gascoyne in Western Australia as well as a small area of southeast Western Australia, areas around the coast of the Cape York Peninsula in Queensland, and eastern New South Wales.

April started with minimum temperatures warmer than average across much of Australia. The southeast observed some cooler-than-average nights around the 3rd under the passage of a high pressure system, but it was not until the 7th that cool nights became more widespread as another high passing the Great Australian Bight extended a pressure ridge well inland.


Cloud over the southwest kept nights warmer than average between the 9th and 11th, with warm minimum temperature anomalies then travelling eastward across southern Australia and becoming widespread around mid-month. Nights remained warmer than average until the 19th in eastern Australia, although were generally cooler than average for the south of Western Australia and adjacent South Australia.

From the 20th minima were significantly cooler than average over much of southeastern Australia as a cold front crossed the southeast to be followed by the East Coast Low which tracked down the coast of New South Wales. Minima remained generally cooler than average for the rest of the month, although Tasmania and Victoria saw milder nights on the 23rd and 24th. The morning of the 27th saw some very cool minima in eastern Queensland.


Rainfall

Nationally-averaged rainfall during April was 9% below the long-term mean. Rainfall was above average for most of New South Wales, extending into East Gippsland in Victoria, parts of southern Queensland, and covering most of eastern South Australia and the West Coast District of South Australia. An East Coast Low brought exceedingly heavy rainfall to the central east coast during the latter part of the month. Rainfall was below average for large areas of the north of both the Northern Territory and of Queensland, and for all of Tasmania. Tasmania had its fifth-driest April on record; all but the eastern third of Tasmania received April rainfall in the lowest 10% of records (decile 1).

The start of the month saw an extensive area of cloud extend from central Western Australia to south of Tasmania as a cold front and strong upper-level trough tracked across central and southern Australia. The system brought moderate falls to parts of central and southern Western Australia in the 24 hours to 9 am on the 1st. Strong onshore flow in the east and a surface trough located through western Queensland generated thunderstorms and showers with light to moderate falls in parts of Queensland's southern interior and heavier falls along the coast of New South Wales and Queensland. Daily rainfall totals exceeded 100 mm in parts of southeastern Queensland. As the

front passed through the southeast moderate falls were recorded in western Tasmania.

A broad area of low pressure across northern Australia triggered thunderstorms and showers in parts of the Kimberley, Top End, and Gulf Country during the first week of the month, with showers also continuing over the eastern Gascoyne.

By the 3rd, the surface trough located through inland Queensland and New South Wales deepened, with moderate to heavy falls continuing along the east coast, becoming widespread in the 48 hours to 9 am on the 5th.

A cold front crossed the southeast on the 6th, with an associated low pressure centre deepening as the system moved off the New South Wales coast during the 7th and 8th. Moderate falls were recorded over parts of southeastern South Australia, central to eastern Victoria, and eastern New South Wales, with heavy rainfall in parts of eastern New South Wales and eastern Victoria.

Between the 6th and 9th, showers and storms associated with a broad area of low pressure around the northern coastline produced moderate rainfall in the northern Top End and areas of the northern Cape York Peninsula.

Between the 8th and 13th a low pressure system and associated surface trough near the west coast of southwest Western Australia deepened before tracking over the southwest of Western Australia, then slowly moved eastwards and south of Esperance. The system generated moderate to heavy rainfall across the southwest and southern coast of Western Australia lasting several days. Moist onshore flow along the east coast of Queensland during the same time generated showers and isolated thunderstorms, with moderate falls recorded in Queensland's north tropical coast, parts of the Cape York Peninsula and small areas of the east coast south of St Lawrence.

In the days following the 14th a pair of cold fronts, connected to a surface trough extending from northwest Western Australia, brought moderate falls across much of southern Australia as they tracked eastward. A number of locations in South Australia observed their wettest April day (see page 16) on the 17th, with 24 hour rainfall totals to 9 am on the 17th approaching or exceeding 100 mm in some locations around the Flinders Ranges.

Moist, onshore airflow onto the east coast of Australia and a surface trough in the northwest brought moderate falls to the north tropical and central coasts

of Queensland and isolated parts of the Gulf Country between the 17th and 19th.

Another cold front passed over the southeast during the 18th, with a low pressure centre developing behind the front and intensifying to become an East Coast Low by the 20th. The front brought light to moderate rain over large parts of New South Wales and northeastern Victoria. The East Coast Low produced very heavy rainfall on the central east coast of New South Wales over the 48 hours to 9 am on the 22nd, particularly the Hunter and Manning districts, with moderate falls extending into central and northeastern New South Wales. The low moved gradually southeastward, with moderate rainfall totals recorded in southern coast New South Wales and eastern Victoria in the 24 hours to 9 am on the 23rd. By the 24th the low had weakened and decayed into a broad trough over the Tasman Sea. A number of rainfall records were set in New South Wales during this event (see Significant Weather section and rainfall records (see page 16) for details).

Thunderstorm activity generated moderate rainfall in parts of northwest Western Australia between the 17th and 22nd, largely associated with an upper level



disturbance and a low pressure system offshore of northwest Western Australia. Showers and storm activity in the northeast of the Top End and the eastern Cape York Peninsula associated with an upper level trough resulted in some moderate falls during the same period.

A weakening cold front and low pressure system approached the southeast from the Great Australian Bight on the 24th, with embedded thunderstorms producing moderate falls in the Lower Eyre Peninsula, Yorke Peninsula and Mount Lofty Ranges in South Australia, northeastern Tasmania, parts of southern central to eastern Victoria, and southeastern New South Wales before the system moved offshore by the morning of the 26th.

At the end of the month, a surface trough deepened over the interior of Queensland and New South Wales, while an upper level trough intensified over Queensland's southern interior, generating widespread, moderate rainfall to the east of the trough along Queensland's central to southeastern coast, along the New South Wales coast, and in a small area of inland southern Queensland and northern New South Wales.



Daily maximum temperature maps





Daily minimum temperature maps




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Daily rainfall maps
