HY2021 FINAL ELECTRICITY PRICING PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Please find enclosed the final pricing proposal submission for AusNet Electricity Services Pty Ltd (AusNet Services) electricity network customers for the period from 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2021.

Components that accompany this letter include updated versions of the HY2021:

- Annual Tariff Proposal;
- Tariff Approval Models (confidential and public versions);
- Schedule of Tariffs;
- Public Lighting Excluded Service Charges;
- Alternative Control Services Charges, and;
- Prescribed Metering Charges.

These updated components seek to address the following differences between the final pricing proposal and the draft pricing proposal:

- Update the Tariff Approval Model to:
 - reflect the corrected approved distribution revenue, and;
 - amend the formulae in the 'ANS' tab, to correctly reference the CPI-X adjustment and ANS prices;
- Update the Annual Tariff Proposal and Alternative Control Services Charges document to reflect the updated ANS prices;
- Update the Annual Tariff Proposal, Schedule of Tariffs and Prescribed Metering Charges document to reflect that all per annum prices will be charged pro rata for the HY2021 six-month extension period, and;
- Update the Annual Tariff Proposal and Public Lighting Charges document to rectify a pricing error in the Public Lighting written down value and avoidable costs.

The following components were not resubmitted and should be taken as part of the final pricing proposal.

- Energy Forecasting Methodology Overview;
- Standalone and Avoidable Cost Model, and;
- Confidentiality Template.
