ATO Ruling on liabilities from Victorian Government's Powerline Replacement Fund contributions – negative pass through application

The purpose of this letter is to apply for a negative pass through for a change to tax costs associated with the Victorian Powerline Replacement Fund (PRF).

On the 6th of July, AusNet Services wrote to you to inform you of an Australian Tax Office (ATO) ruling that had the effect of materially altering the tax liability associated with the PRF. The letter also proposed a \$5.72 million adjustment to 2016 revenue to return the revenues approved for the current regulatory period for tax costs from the PRF.

AER staff have since informed AusNet Services that it is not possible to make this revenue adjustment without a negative pass through application.

AusNet Services submits that the ATO private ruling, constituted a tax change event and was a negative change event. The negative change event occurred on 8 May 2015, the date of the ATO ruling. The costs AusNet Services is likely to save as a result of the negative change event are \$5.72 million. It is proposed \$5.72 million is the amount that should be passed through to the Distribution Network Users, and that all costs would be passed through in the 2016 regulatory year.

This letter is accompanied with an updated Post Tax Revenue Model to that provided on the 6th July 2015. The model contains confidential information. It is the same model provided to the Australian Energy Regulator (AER) in a separate email on 10 September 2015¹. All other relevant information was provided in AusNet Services' 6th July letter.
