ROLR NOTICE

The Australian Energy Regulator (AER) has issued this Notice under section 136 of the National Energy Retail Law (NERL).

RoLR Event

A Retailer of Last Resort (RoLR) event has occurred in relation to COzero Energy Retail Pty Ltd (COzero) (ABN 85 165 155 966) with the registered participant identification “COZEROER” in the National Electricity Market. Prior to the issue of this notice, COzero was an authorised electricity retailer for the purposes of Part 5 of the NERL with the authorisation identification E13053.

On 20 June 2018, the Federal Court of Australia made an order for the winding up of COzero and a liquidator was appointed. The making of an order for the winding up of a retailer and the appointment of a liquidator are RoLR events under section 122 of the NERL.

Affected Markets

As at 2 July 2018, COzero will have no customers, therefore this Notice affects no customers.

Revocation of COzero electricity retailer authorisation

Under section 142 of the NERL, the AER revokes COzero’s electricity retailer authorisation (AER reference E13053) with effect from AEST 24:00 2 July 2018. This means that, for the purposes of section 88 of the NERL, COzero must not engage in the activity of selling electricity to a person for premises in New South Wales, Queensland, the Australian Capital Territory, South Australia and Tasmania.
