- 1.1 General duties for the provision of pipeline services of covered pipeline services by a service provider

 - Country Energy Gas does not carry on a related business. The Associate Contract between Country Energy and Country Energy Gas Pty Limited was reviewed in January 2008. This contract provides Country Energy access to the covered network to allow retail natural gas sales.

 - Yes. Consolidated accounts cover the whole of the business for Country Energy Gas Pty Ltd.
