I am writing in response to the proposed Natural Gas Pipeline extension from Murray Bridge to Mount Barker. I am a resident of Nairne and also the local North Ward Councillor for the Mount Barker District Council. On behalf of myself and my constituents I implore you ensure that Nairne is serviced as part of this extension.

Nairne has seen substantial growth over the past 10 years and I quote the 2016 Census figures which state there are currently 1,995 private dwellings with 5,042 persons. There is still residential land within the town boundary yet to be subdivided. Working on the standard housing block that equates to 530 lots, at the rate of 2.6 persons per household – 1,378 people. This amount could increase if the land divisions include high density housing.

The growth in this area can be confirmed by contacting the Mount Barker District Council planning and development staff.

Having lived in Blackheath in the Blue Mountains, NSW up until we moved here in 2008 we were fortunate to have had natural gas connection. When we moved to Nairne we were quite shocked realising we had to resort to gas bottles.
