- We have prepared the first draft of an infographic showing all the dispute resolution provisions under the NER. Feedback is invited. Please email me if you haven't yet received a copy of the infographic.

Update Panels.

 We are updating our panel of experts and adding some independent engineers for the Chapter 5 provisions.



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- WEMDRA will be running an EOI for panel members in August/Septmeber through industry peak bodies. Your suggestions are welcome if you have great consultants in the network.
- We will also be updating the user notes and contracts to support this function.

Refine. Consult

- We expect the update to be complete by the end of September (the next quarter).
 We will then be able to speak to some of the key stakeholders to identify where refinements/changes can be made. This consultation will start with AEMO and AER.
- We hope to provide feedback on Refine and consult first quarter next year.

Recommend
