Time of Day and Season Definitions

Time-Of-Day Definitions for all Non-Residential Time of Use Tariffs

The application of our rates to customers on non-residential time of use tariffs for ‘Peak’, ‘Shoulder’ and ‘Off-peak’ periods is based on the time periods detailed below.

During Eastern Standard Time (EST), and during Daylight Saving Time (DST):

Business Days

- Peak: 1300-2000
- Shoulder: 0700-1300 & 2000-2200
- Off-peak: All other times.

The following definition of three distinct Seasons applies to all time of use demand tariffs, for the purpose of charging demand each month, namely

Summer (S)

01 November, 00.00h to 31 March, 24.00h

Winter (W)

01 June, 00.00h to 31 August, 24.00h

Other Months (O)

01 September, 00.00h to 31 October, 24.00h

01 April, 00.00h to 31 May, 24.00h
