Essential Energy's 2019-20 Pricing Proposal

I am pleased to provide Essential Energy's 2019-20 Pricing Proposal (pricing proposal) to the Australian Energy Regulator (AER) and advise that it complies with the terms of the AER's 2019-24 Final Determination for Essential Energy ("the Determination").

The pricing proposal has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 6 of the National Electricity Rules (NER) which establishes a process of price notification and review by the AER for annual price changes. The pricing proposal also follows the structures detailed in the Determination – Tariff Structure Statement (TSS). The Indicative Pricing Schedule contained in the TSS has been updated for each tariff component due to:

- a higher allowed revenue for 2019-20 than estimated;
- an increase in transmission use of system (TUoS) pass through costs for 2019-20; and
- a reduction in the Climate Change Fund (CCF) contribution for 2019-20.

Essential Energy is also proposing to delay the revenue earned from the Service Target Performance Incentive Scheme (STPIS) in 2017-18, for one year as per Clause 2.5(d) of the STPIS Guideline 2018. The business is forecasting an unfavourable STPIS outcome for 2018-19 (to be applied to prices in 2020-21). Combining the STPIS revenue outcomes for 2017-18 and 2018-19, would reduce price variations for customers. Please refer to Attachment 8 for further detail on STPIS outcomes.
