Evoenergy 2022/23 electricity network pricing proposal

Evoenergy is pleased to submit its 2022/23 electricity network pricing proposal in accordance with the requirements of the National Electricity Rules and the Australian Energy Regulator's (AER's) Final Decision for Evoenergy's 2019-24 electricity network distribution determination.

The pricing proposal submission contains the following.

- Electricity network pricing proposal (confidential *word* version, and public and confidential *pdf* versions) containing our proposed tariffs and charges for the 2022/23 financial year.
- Standardised pricing model (confidential) recently developed by the AER.
- Alternative control services (ACS) pricing model recently developed by the AER. Note that Evoenergy have not made any changes to the draft ACS pricing model submitted to the AER on 18 February 2022, except to add two new ACS codes as per correspondence with the AER on 21 and 24 February 2022.
- Source documents for the large-scale feed-in tariff scheme, utilities network facilities tax and transmission pricing.
- A confidentiality claim.
