Overview

As a part of this revised regulatory proposal, Jemena Electricity Network (Vic) Ltd (**JEN**) claims confidentiality over some of the materials. JEN is making this confidential information available to assist the AER to perform its functions under the National Electricity Rules. These claims and the approach to presenting them are made in accordance with the requirements of the Australian Energy Regulator's (**AER**'s) confidentiality guideline.¹

JEN has detailed how and why the disclosure of the information would cause detriment to the business or our customers. JEN considers that, in each case, the confidentiality reasons—together with the benefits already realised through the AER's confidential use of this data—are not outweighed by any additional public benefit to disclosure of the information.

JEN identifies the confidential information in the revised proposal documents by highlighting the content in yellow text [____]. It has not been possible to highlight all diagrams or elements included as pictures in documents due to document formatting restrictions. In these instances, JEN has made it clear in section 1 that the relevant item is subject to a confidentiality claim.

Where we provide confidential information, and therefore the document is identified as confidential, an equivalent public version of the document is also provided – the public document has the relevant confidential sections redacted. This approach applies in all cases, except where the whole document is flagged as confidential, in which case, only a confidential version of the document is provided.

JEN has marked confidential information in spreadsheets by formatting the cells as [C-i-C] or [____].

2. **Proportion of confidential information**

Section 3.3 of the AER's confidentiality guideline requires Network Service Providers to complete the proportion of confidential material notice as part of the manner in which they must make confidentiality claims. JEN must specify the number of pages in their submissions which contain a confidential claim and the number of pages which do not. Table 2–1 contains the required information for our revised proposal covering the next regulatory period.
