10.4 Assessment and Decision Process

ENERGEX and Powerlink intend to carry out the following process to assess what action, if any, should be taken to address the identified network limitations, **which will enable any solution to be implemented in advance of the 2005/06 summer.**

Part 1	Initial Information Request (this paper). Submissions (responses to this paper).	June. July.
Part 2	Review and analysis. Likely to involve further consultation with Code participants and interested parties. Additional data may be requested to allow ENERGEX and Powerlink to carry out the economic assessment process as required by the National Electricity Code and the ACCC Regulatory Test.	July to November.
Part 3	Presentation of draft report and recommendation of solution which satisfies the Regulatory Test. Submissions on draft report. Presentation of final report and recommendation.	December December/January March/April.
