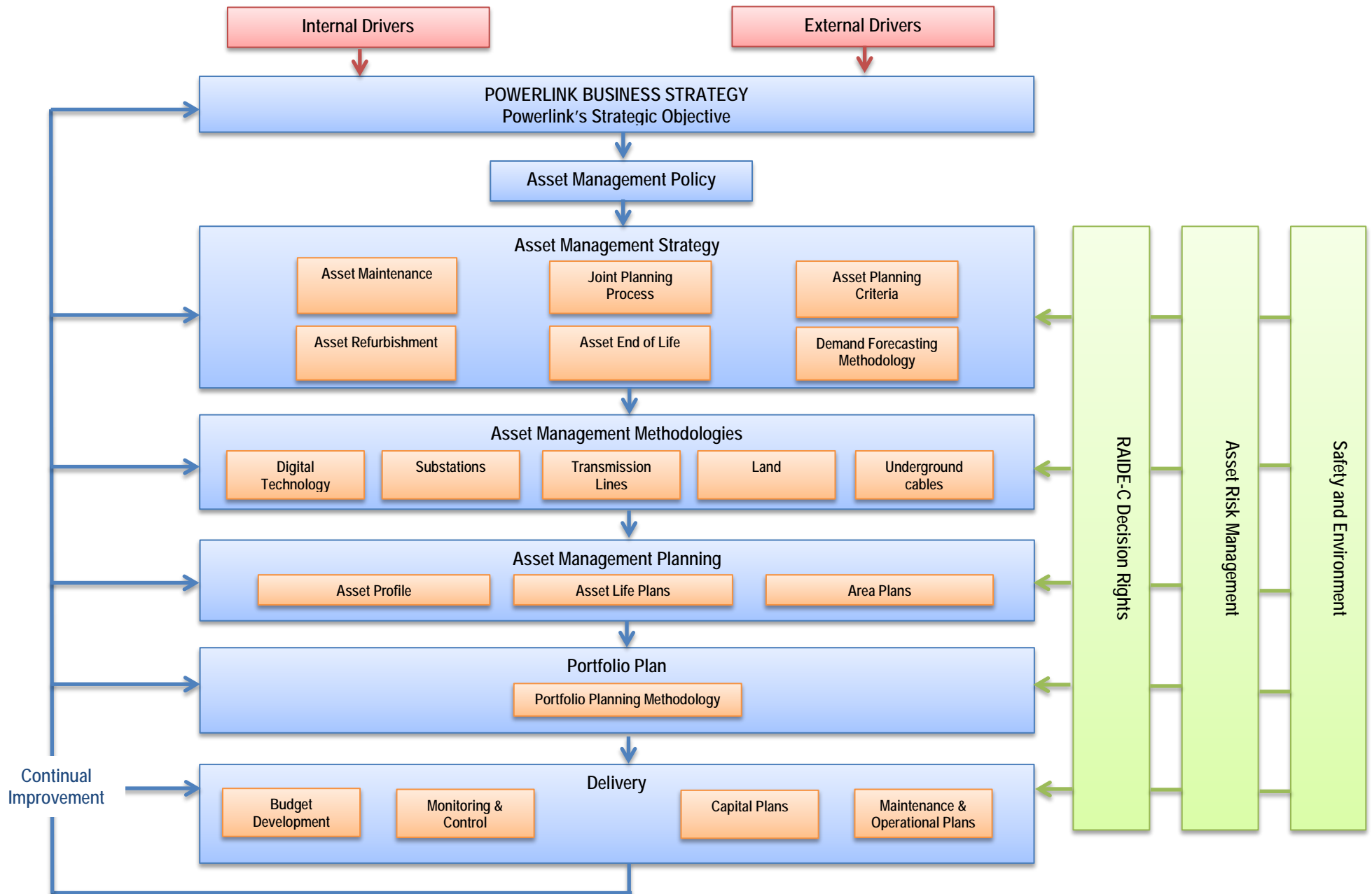
### 1.4 Defined terms
