Having our business location set up outside any major town, the availability of their training courses gives us the opportunity to complete this without the need for long distance travel or accommodation.

Provider of Last Resort - If a customer is having trouble gaining the services of an ASP, I feel they probably haven't explored their options. There are now a number of Level 1 / 2 / 3 ASP's set up on the Resource and Energy website who can and will cover off a large area.
